Course Description

The Diploma course is a natural progression from the Foundation level. Candidates who have relevant entry requirements may also take it. Successful completion leads to the award of a Diploma, which equates to a National Certificate.

Entry Qualifications

- a) Completion of the Core and Mandatory Modules at Foundation level
- b) 4 GCSE passes at grade C or above, including English and a numerate subject.

Candidates of 21 years of age and over, with 2 years' relevant work experience.
